Invitation/Challenge

I overheard a discussion in a previous church about the creed. The disagreement was not about who God is, but about whether it should be "I believe..." or "We believe". I can see it both ways. Affirming my faith is about what *I believe*, but I am part of a church family who support each other through all that life brings so when we worship together it is also what *we believe*.
