Invitation/Challenge

We use the word love in so many ways – "I love a cup of tea first thing in the morning", "I love my dog", "I loved this book", "I love God", "I love you". The word means different things in the ways we use it. In many stations we mean "I really like". Yet Jesus asks me to love people I find it hard to like. And Jesus continued to love his friend Simon Peter, even when Simon Peter betrayed Jesus 3 times when Jesus had been arrested. The words of Jesus today are an invitation and a tricky challenge. Let us pray for wisdom and love.
